Princeton's Last Time Out

Junior Trocon Davis picked off a trick pass late in the second quarter and returned it for a Princeton record 100 yards to lead the Tigers to a 29-7 win at Yale last weekend. Sophomore quarterback Quinn Epperly ran for a touchdown and threw for another to lead Princeton, which won its first game at the Yale Bowl since 2006.

Dartmouth's Last Time Out

Junior Dominick Pierre ran the ball 28 times for 136 yards and two touchdowns, but Dartmouth was unable to hold onto a 10-point lead in the final seven minutes against Brown. An 18-yard touchdown pass with 1:14 remaining gave the Bears a 28-24 road victory; that score capped a drive that saw Dartmouth recover a Brown fumble that had been ruled to have touched the sideline before the Big Green took possession.

That Winning Feeling

With Princeton's 29-7 victory over Yale last weekend, the Tigers enter today with a chance to clinch the program's first winning season since the 2006 Ivy League championship season. The current stretch of six consecutive seasons without a winning record is the program's longest since an eight-year streak between 1971 and 1978.

Head Of The Class

Princeton will also be looking to send its senior class out with a victory. The Class of 2013, which is featured on Page 4 of this week's game program, has helped bring the program from consecutive one-win seasons to the top half of the Ivy League standings, and possibly even more.

Seeing Red

While Princeton can control a winning season and a positive exit for its senior class, it can also hope for a share of the program's 10th Ivy League championship. If Princeton defeats Dartmouth and Cornell defeats Penn (a 12:30 start in Ithaca), Princeton would clinch either a two-way or three-way (if Harvard also wins) share of the Ivy League title.

As a reminder, Harvard was picked to finish first in the Ivy League. Penn was picked to finish second. Princeton was picked to finish last. Both Harvard and Penn won one Ivy League title apiece between the last two seasons. During that stretch, Princeton won one Ivy League game.

Poll Position

A Princeton win would assure the Tigers no worse than a second-place finish in the Ivy League. Only one team picked to finish eighth has ever finished second (Yale, 1998). No team ever picked to finish last has ended the year as Ivy League champion.

Rising Up

Princeton has already assured itself its biggest turnaround season in more than 20 years. The last Tiger team to win at least four more games than it had the previous season was the 1991 team, which improved from 3-7 (1990) to 8-2. That team featured a sophomore running back named Keith Elias, who ended his career as Princeton's all-time rushing leader.

World Series

The all-time series with Dartmouth is the closest of any of Princeton's Ivy League opponents. The Tigers, who won six straight between 2004-2009 to temporarily take a one-game lead, trails Dartmouth 44-43-4 in a series that dates back to Oct. 30, 1897.

Fired Up

One of the Princeton traditions is to hold a bonfire for the team on Cannon Green during any season that it sweeps the "Big Three." For the 25th time in program history, Princeton swept Harvard (39-34) and Yale (29-7), and will be honored with a bonfire Saturday night at 7 pm.

Harvard led Princeton 34-10 with 12 minutes remaining in the fourth quarter on Powers Field during Week 6, and Yale led Princeton 7-0 in the Yale Bowl early last week. In both cases, Princeton finished the game scoring 29 unanswered points to secure the victory.

Just Quinn, Baby

Sophomore quarterback Quinn Epperly has both rushed for a touchdown and thrown for a touchdown in three of Princeton's last four games. He has accounted for nine Tiger touchdowns in the last four weeks (five passing, four rushing), and he currently ranks third in the Ivy League in passing efficiency.

First Impression

Quinn Epperly made his first career start in the 2011 season finale at Dartmouth. He rushed for two touchdowns in a 24-17 loss and was named the Ivy League Rookie of the Week.

When In Roman

Junior wideout Roman Wilson has scored at least one touchdown in six of Princeton's last seven games. He rushed for a one-yard score last weekend to even the score at 7-7 against Yale, and he caught the game-

winning 34-yard touchdown pass from Quinn Epperly to lead Princeton past Harvard.

Quarterly Report

Princeton hasn't scored a first quarter point since the Week 5 game against Brown, when Spencer Huston took a throwback and ran for a 15-yard touchdown. Princeton's only two scores in the first quarter over the last six games have been Huston's run and a 93-yard kickoff return for a touchdown on the first play at Columbia.

Princeton has 21 first-quarter points this season. The Tigers have at least three times as many in every other quarter (71 in both the second and third, 82 in the fourth).

Sack Exchange

Senior Mike Catapano, who will be playing his final game today, leads the Ivy League and ranks second nationally with 1.1 sacks per game. Seven of his sacks have come in Ivy League games, including two apiece against Columbia, Brown and Penn.

Tackling The Issue

The race for the Ivy League tackle leader will come down to the final weekend, and two of the top three currently will be on the field today. Columbia's Zach Olinger leads the league with 9.2 stops per game (83 total), while Dartmouth's Michael Runger is second

with 9.0 stops (81). Princeton senior Andrew Starks, a two-time All-Ivy League selection, is third with 8.9 stops (80).

Return To Sender

Junior Trocon Davis' 100-yard interception return last weekend matched the school record of James Anderson, who did the same during a victory at Cornell on Sept. 22, 1984.

Good And Bad

In Princeton's five wins this season, it is a +7 in turnover margin. In its four losses, the team is a -5.

In losses to Cornell and Penn, Princeton has struggled with turnovers in the fourth quarter. In both games, the Tigers turned the ball over on three of their final four possessions. In the victories over Harvard and Yale, Princeton was far more efficient at the end of the game; the Tigers scored touchdowns on their final four drives against Harvard, and they scored on a drive that took 6:57 off the clock in the fourth quarter against Yale.

Return To Sender

Freshman Anthony Gaffney is not only third in the league in interceptions and passes defended, but he also leads the league in kickoff returns. Gaffney averages 26.5 yards per kick return, and his 59-yard return in the fourth quarter against Harvard set up the first points in Princeton's 29-point 4th quarter. Gaffney made quite the splash in his Ivy debut; he returned the opening kickoff at Columbia 94 yards for a touchdown. The Tigers were either tied or leading for the next 188:44 of game action.

Welcome Matt

Freshman Matt Arends has started four games opposite of Anthony Gaffney after Khamal Brown was lost for the season. In the last four, he has averaged more than seven tackles per game, and he has recorded at least one pass breakup over each of the five starts.

We're Honored

Sophomore quarterback Connor Michelsen was named the Ivy League Offensive Player of the Week after leading Princeton to the comeback win over Harvard. Michelsen's honor gave Princeton at least one individual award per week for a span of four weeks. Anthony Gaffney has won two Rookie honors, while both Mike Catapano and Caraun Reid have won Defensive Player honors. Nolan Bieck has a Special Teams honor.

Princeton is one of two Ivy League schools to have won each individual award at least once; the other is Dartmouth.

THE CHARLES W. CALDWELL JR. '25 HEAD COACH OF FOOTBALL



Bob Surace '90, a key member of the 1989 Ivy League champion Princeton football team, is in his third year as the Charles W. Caldwell Jr. '25 Head Coach of Football at Princeton University. He had been an assistant coach for the Cincinnati Bengals for the prior nine seasons and helped the team to an AFC North title in 2009.



Surace has been given the responsibility of rebuilding the Princeton football program, and he has seen some impressive performances from his first two recruiting classes, including 2011 Ivy League Rookie of the Year

Chuck Dibilio, who rushed for more yards (1,068) than any other true freshman in Ivy League history last season. Princeton had the top rushing offense in the Ivy League in 2011, and the Tigers have had 16 All-Ivy League players in Surace's two seasons.

The 22nd head coach at Princeton, Surace was a first-team All-Ivy center when he helped the 1989 Tigers to a 6-1 league mark and a share of the Ivy title. In addition to his tenure with the Bengals, Surace was also the head coach at Division III Western Connecticut State University, where he put together an 18-3 record in 2000 and 2001.

Surace (pronounced "suh-RACE") had served as assistant offensive line coach for the Bengals for the last six years of his time with Cincinnati; prior to that, he served two seasons as an offensive staff assistant. In addition to his work with the line, he played a key role in the entire offensive staff's game preparation. In 2009, that offense helped the Bengals to a 10-6 record and a sweep of their AFC North rivals, including the defending Super Bowl champion Pittsburgh Steelers.

Under Surace's leadership, Western Connecticut advanced to the second round of the NCAA Division III Championship and won the Freedom Football Con-

ference title in 2001; the win in the NCAA playoffs was the first in school history. In 2000, the Colonials won the Northeast Championship ECAC playoff game. In both of Surace's seasons, the team ranked in the top 25 nationally in the American Football Coaches Association poll.

Surace grew up in a coaching family. His father, Tony, was head coach for his high school football and baseball teams in Millville, N.J.

Surace began his coaching career in 1990 as running backs coach at Springfield (Mass.) College, where he also earned a master's degree in sports management in 1992.

In 1994, when the Canadian Football League fielded teams in the U.S., Surace was with the Shreveport Pirates as the assistant to head coach and general manager Forrest Gregg, the former Bengals coach who guided Cincinnati to Super Bowl XVI.

His wife, Lisa, was a four-time letterwinner in women's soccer at Princeton and is a member of the Class of 1992. She holds a Ph.D. in psychology and is now the Lower School Head at Princeton Day School.

They have a daughter, Alison, and a son, A.J.

Surace is part of one of the richest traditions in all of college football. Princeton was involved in the first college football game ever played on Nov. 6, 1869, and has played a total of 778 all-time games with an all-time winning percentage of .675 and five former head coaches in the College Football Hall of Fame: William W. Roper, Fritz Crisler, Tad Wieman, Charles W. Caldwell, Jr. and Dick Colman.

James Perry, the all-time leading passer in Ivy League history, is in his third season as the offensive coordinator at Princeton in 2012 as he continues to bring his style of fast and physical football to Old Nassau.

In his first four weeks of the 2010 season, prior to a season-ending injury to starting quarterback Tommy Wornham, Princeton had the top-ranked wide receiver in the FCS (Trey Peacock) and the 12th-ranked player in total offense (Wornham). Last season, Princeton posted the top-ranked rushing offense in the league, and Perry saw freshman quarterback Quinn Epperly earn Ivy League Rookie of the Week honors in his first collegiate start at Dartmouth.

Perry, a former Ivy League Player of the Year and quarterback for the 1999 Brown Ivy League championship squad, came to Princeton after spending three years as a highly successful offensive assistant coach at his alma mater. Perry coached the quarterbacks and was the recruiting coordinator at Brown.

As an undergraduate at Brown, Perry led the Bears to the Ivy League championship in 1999, and he holds virtually every school and Ivy League passing record, including passing yards in a season (3,255) and career (9,294), completions in a season (309) and career (789), touchdown passes in a game (6) and career (74), and total offense in a career (9,236). He threw for over 400 yards in a game six times during his career, and he threw the first touchdown pass ever at Princeton Stadium.

He was a Walter Payton Award Finalist as a senior and won the Bulger Lowe Award as the Outstanding Offensive Player in New England. A three-time first team All-Ivy selection, Perry graduated from Brown with a Bachelor of Arts degree, and he went on to earn a Master's degree in Education Policy & Leadership from the University of Maryland in 2006.

JARED BACKUS

DEF. COORDINATOR/LBs



Jared Backus, who has 18 seasons of collegiate coaching experience, is in his third season as the Princeton defensive coordinator.

He came to Princeton after three years as a defensive assistant coach at Temple University, where he helped rebuild the struggling program into a bowl-eligible football team.

While coordinating the Princeton defense, Backus also works with the Princeton linebackers. In his first two seasons, Backus has placed four of his linebackers on the All-Ivy League team. Andrew Starks, who has earned All-Ivy honors each of the last two seasons, ranked fourth in the Ivy League in tackles in both 2010 and 2011.

The Tigers also saw several defensive improvements during the 2011 season; the most impressive one came in rushing defense, where Princeton moved from seventh in 2010 to third in 2011.

After coaching the line for his first two seasons at Temple, Backus took over the linebacking corps during the fall of 2009. His only season as linebackers coach was one of the most memorable in the history of Temple athletics. The Owls won nine straight games and earned a berth in The Eagle-Bank Bowl.

Prior to joining the Owls, Backus spent five seasons at Bucknell, first coaching outside linebackers/special teams (2002) and defensive line/special teams (2003-04), before being promoted to defensive coordinator and linebackers coach (2005-06).

Backus was a two-year varsity letterwinner and one-year starter at linebacker at Springfield, earning a degree in physical education in 1993. He received a master of physical education degree from Springfield in 1998.

He and wife Amanda have a son, Garrett, and a daughter, Grace.
